SCREENING FOR HEART DISEASE

HEART FAILURE/SUDDEN CARDIAC DEATH MEASUREMENT (Ejection Fraction)

The ejection fraction (EF) is an important measurement in determining how well your heart is pumping out blood and in diagnosing and tracking heart failure. This completed by echocardiography, the ultrasound is a simple, non-invasive test that uses inaudible sound waves to make two-dimensional images of the heart's walls and motions.

Atrial Fibrillation Screening

Atrial Fibrillation is the most common type of heart arrhythmia (abnormal heart-beat). It occurs when the heart's upper chambers (the atria) beat irregularly or quiver. Without an effective heartbeat blood isn't pumped completely out of the atria, causing blood to pool and possibly clot.

BIOMETRICS

Height and weight measurements to better understand the state of your health so you can take the necessary steps to improve it.

High Blood Pressure Screening

Quick and easy, this test is performed at every one of our heart screenings. It involves a pressure cuff being placed around your upper arm to monitor both diastolic and systolic blood pressure.
